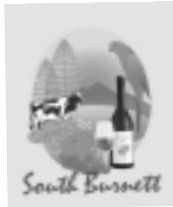

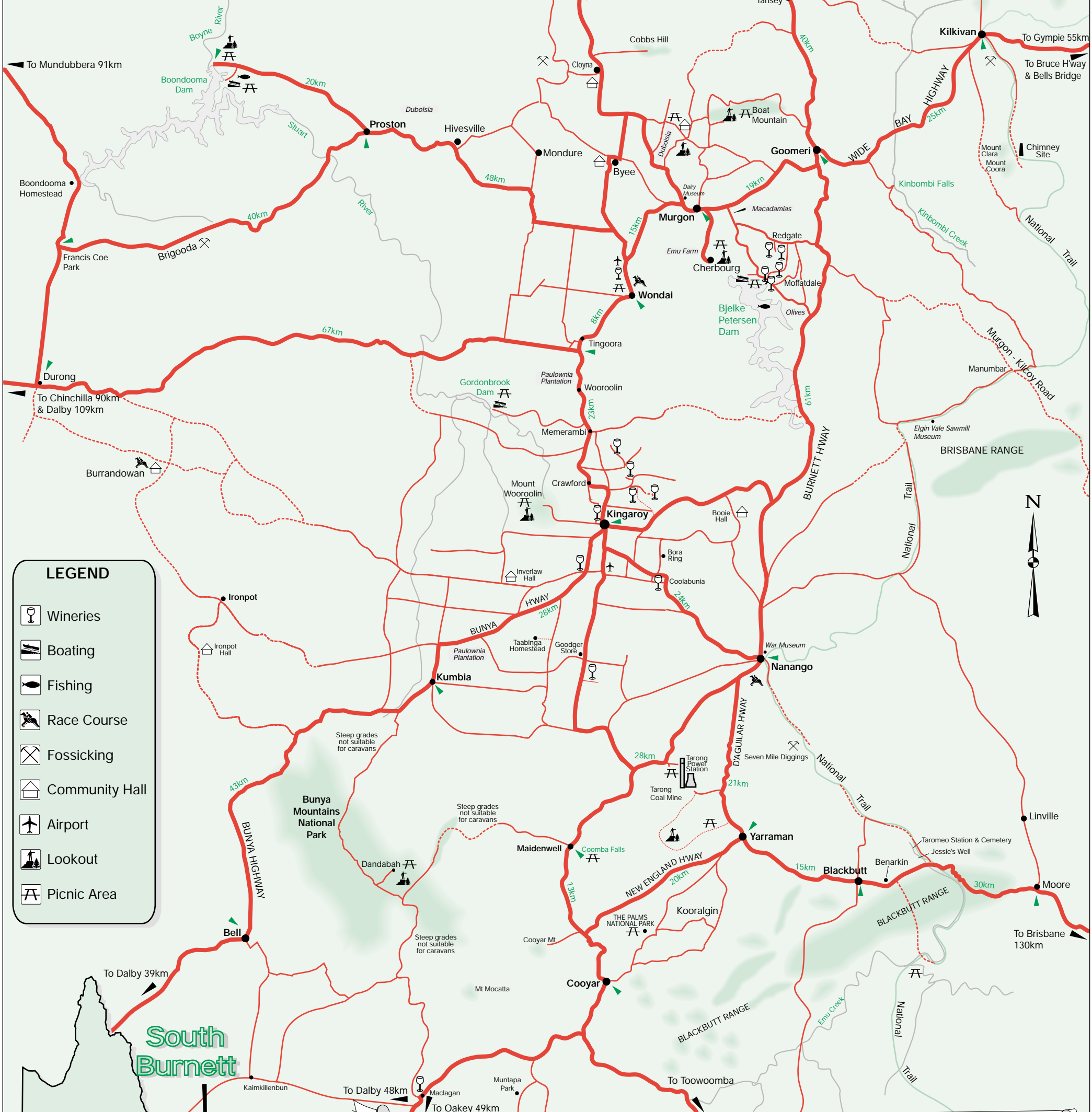

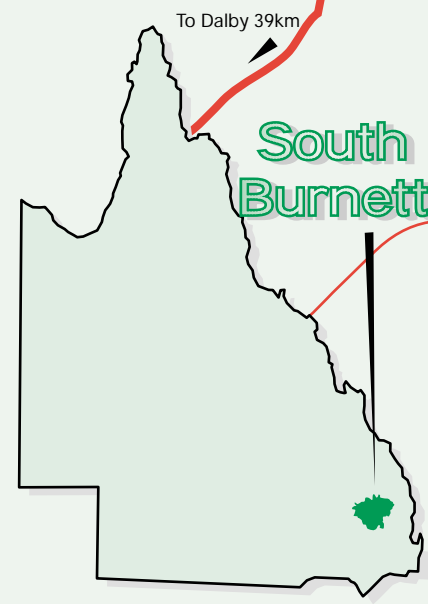

Did you know...

- The South Burnett boasts Queensland's newest and fastest growing wine region....
- Nanango is the fourth oldest town in Queensland, established in 1848....
- Boondooma Dam is the largest storage of fresh water in the South Burnett, constructed in 1983 to supply water for Tarong Power Station and irrigation....
- The South Burnett has a combined population of over 35,000....
- Over 1,000 horse riders pass through Kilkivan each year during the Great Horse Ride....
- The Bunya Mountains has the largest stand of Bunya Pines located in one area in the world and boasts specimens of some of Australia's rarest orchids....
- Boat Mountain, Murgon is home to some of the oldest marsupial fossils found in Australia....
- The Yarraman/Blackbutt area has 16,000 hectares of drive through hoop pine forestry....
- Kingaroy is home to Australia's longest serving Premier, Sir Joh Bjelke-Petersen and is the peanut and navy bean capital of Australia....
